



Napperby Project

- 150 km from Alice Springs on bitumen road
- Subject of a pre-feasibility study by Uranerz in 1970s
- 20 x 4 km area of uranium mineralisation delineated within 10 m of surface
- DYL completed 600 holes targeting a JORC resource, but poor core recovery and inconsistent assays not conducive to JORC rules / resource definition
- Trenching completed to define style of mineralisation and understand disequilibrium problems
- Drilling of 250 large diameter (60 cm) holes on 50 x 50 m grid underway







Four Selected Enhanced Plan Sections within the Deep Yellow Drilled Area (red holes in previous slide)






Minus 5 m





Tanami – Arunta

- Acquired 100% rights to uranium within Tanami Gold's tenements covering 50,732 km²
- Ongoing studies by Deep Yellow of available data defines substantial new targets
- New Deep Yellow 100% tenements 6,375 km²
- Commenced CLC and Landowner negotiations for access to prospective areas









Tanami – Arunta - Officer Project






Officer Project – Uranium Channel







NW Joint Venture

- Matrix Metals Ltd acquired the uranium rights to ~5000 km² around Mt Isa and Cloncurry
- Multiple uranium anomalies and drill intercepts for immediate follow-up
- Lochness Prospect significant regional uranium anomaly, large untested ferruginous outcrop / alteration zone
- Access agreements in place
- Commenced evaluation work in May 2006








South Australia - Western Gawler Project

- Dominion Gold Operations Ltd Acquired the uranium rights to 3,295 km²
- Negotiations to include a further 2,000 km²
- +40,000 calcrete sample in database from surface sampling and shallow drilling – no uranium assays
- Several southwest to south flowing palaeodrainages draining uraniferous granites
- PIRSA has decided to assay samples. Delay, but substantial savings









South Australia - Frome Basin Database / Siccus JV


- Acquired Paladin Database covering ~25,000km²
- Covers known sandstone / ISL deposits Beverley and Honeymoon
- One tenement held (90%) with palaeochannel / drill targets at ±150 m depth. Access to be negotiated
- New discovery by Alliance Resources 50 km to the north enhancing prospectivity



Frome Basin – Siccus JV & Alliance Discovery










Looking Forward
