Uranio Limited Acquires 100% of Ponton North Project

Uranio Limited ("Uranio") has acquired Deep Yellow Limited's 30% carried interest in the five Ponton North tenements for a cash consideration of \$150,000.

The tenements are located approximately 200km northeast of Kalgoorlie, surrounding the Mulga Rock uranium deposits and lying directly to the northeast of Uranio's 100% owned Double 8 uranium deposit in Western Australia.




Figure 1: Location of the Five Ponton North Tenements
